Re: FY17 TIDC-Follow-up Monitoring Review – Response from the County Criminal Courts and County Criminal Courts of Appeals

## Dear Judge Jenkins:

The Dallas County Criminal Courts and the County Criminal Courts of Appeals will Address the recommendation of the TIDC's 2017 Report as follows.

TIDC Recommendation: The misdemeanor courts will continue to examine their methods of appointing counsel, in particular, with regard to non-Spanish speaking attorneys. The Dallas County Criminal Courts and Criminal Courts of Appeals showed the top 10% of court appointed attorneys received 4.4 times their representative share. The recommended threshold by the Commission is 3.0 of the top 10% of appointed attorneys.

County Criminal Courts and County Criminal Courts of Appeals response and actions are as follows:

- 1. Will review the process of court appointments
  - There is a procedure of appointing the same attorneys to felony and misdemeanor cases for the same defendant. This accounts for an increase of assignments to attorneys.
- 2. Will conduct and maintain an up-to-date attorney wheel list
  - This will insure that the attorney wheel list has only the most current active attorneys on the list.
- 3. Will Review the Summary Attorney Appointment Management Report for updates and changes to reflect accurate attorney assignment data

- Establish direct communication with the Dallas County IT department regarding data issues and updates.
- 4. Review and unify the payment per case process with the courts
  - This will insure that cases are paid uniformly among courts.
- 5. The courts will continue to enforce the use of the automatic appointment wheel for case assignments. Understanding the need for fair and neutral appointments
